LSFA 7-A-SIDE RULES & REGULATIONS

- Games should be played across half a normal soccer pitch (approx size 50mx35m) OR on a purpose-marked area of a similar size.
- At each end of a semi-circular penalty area of approx 10m radius – which has the same status as a normal penalty area i.e. outfield players allowed in, GK cannot handle the ball outside. Goal kicks can be taken from anywhere in or around the penalty area.
- Pitch to have a penalty spot at 6m
- Pitch to have a centre spot, but not necessarily a centre line.
- A recommended goal width of 4m using suitable posts, e.g. rounders posts or other suitable posts of a similar height (with due consideration for safety) OR purpose built 7 aside goals.
- Duration of matches to be 10 minutes each way, or a maximum of 15 minutes each way. This may be shortened for rallies if mutually agreed.
- Recommended ball size 3 OR size 4 if mutually agreed.
- SEVEN players (boys and /or girls) per side, which can be reduced by ONE player.
- The rules are as for a normal 11 a-side EXCEPT that there is no off-side rule. At kick-offs, corners and free kicks opposing players must be no less than 5m from the ball and substitutes to be allowed as and when agreed.
- Points awarded will be as follows:
- 2 points for a win 1 point for a draw 1 point for playing
If you win you receive 3 points (2 for winning and 1 for playing). A draw gives 2 points (1 for the draw and 1 for playing). Losing teams receive 1 point for playing.

RULES

1. That this combination of schools for the playing of Association Football be called 'The Leeds Schools' Football Association'.
2. The objects of the Association shall be the mental, moral and physical development and improvement of school children through the medium of Association Football and to help such charities as the Committee of the Association may from time to time determine.
3. The Association shall be affiliated to the English Schools' Football Association and shall be constituted in accordance with the rules laid down for a 'properly constituted' association in the General Rules of the English Schools' FA.
4. The committee shall control its finance which shall be used solely for the furtherance of the objects stated in Rule 2.
5. In the event of the Association being dissolved the council shall release the property and assets and call in all monies due to the Association and after discharge of all liabilities, hand the surplus to such charitable institutions or charities as shall be determined by the Annual General Meeting or a General Meeting called for that purpose.
6.
 - (a) That all schools in Leeds Metropolitan District and such Institutions as the committee may think fit, be eligible for Membership.
 - (b) Schools not wishing to join any of the leagues or competitions may be elected to honorary membership at any monthly meeting.
 - (c) Any school taking part in an event organised through LSFA, must be affiliated to LSFA.
7.
 - (a) The executive of the Association shall consist of Chairperson, Vice Chair, General Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Primary Schools' Organiser, Senior Schools' Representative, Representatives to West Yorkshire SFA, Leeds & District FA, Leeds Schools' Sports Association, with the power to co-opt City Team Manager/coaches and others.
 - (b) That the management of the Association be vested in a council consisting of the executive, a representative from each school team in membership and the life members, with power to add.
 - (c) That the representative must be on the staff of the school Represented.
8. That the Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer shall be ex-officio members of all committees.
9.
 - (a) That officers shall retire annually, but shall be eligible for re-election in the same capacity or some other capacity.
 - (b) Life membership of the Association may be granted only on the recommendation of the executive to the AGM.
10. That the Emergency Committee, consisting of the Chair, Secretary and Treasurer, will meet at any time the situation demands. That the AGM be held in June each year. Seven days notice of this meeting shall be given.
11. That there shall be no alterations to the rules except at the AGM, to which a representative from each school team in membership during the playing season just closed summoned. No school shall have more than one vote per teacher-trainer, officials and life members excepted. All proposed alterations of the rules and nominations for officers and life members must reach the Hon Secretary on or before 31st May.
12.
 - (a) Entry fees shall be £15 per team. Cup or League only - £10 per team.
 - (b) Schools whether or not taking part in the league, trophy or knock-out competitions, but using the amenities of the Association, shall be affiliated to the Association on the payment of annual £5 subscription.
 - (c) Subscriptions shall be paid with entry form.
13. The Laws of the Game to be those of the Football Association except that:
 - (a) The ball for U15 and above to be size 5; U13 & U12 to be size 4; U11 & U10 to be size 3 or 4.
 - (b) The time for playing be 40 minutes each way for U14, U13; 25 minutes each way for U12; for U11 & U10; 20 minutes each way. By mutual consent all games maybe curtailed by 5 minutes each way.
 - (c) The duration of 6/7 a side games shall not exceed 15 minutes each way.
 - (d) Three substitutions shall be allowed at any time in a game, rolling.
 - (e) Football for Children U10 on September 1st shall be small-sided (mini soccer)
14.
 - (a) All ages to be taken on 31st August of the current season.
 - (b) That a pupil having left school ceases to be an eligible player in any subsequent school games with the following exceptions:
 - 1 That leaving school at Easter shall not preclude any pupil from playing in the remaining matches afterwards.
 - 2 A player having taken part in the final for any LSFA trophy shall be eligible for any replay or replays.

15. A pupil must be on the school roll before Easter to be eligible for any of that season's games played after Easter.
16. No pupil, by changing schools, shall play for different schools in the same competition without the consent of the committee or Emergency Committee.
17. (a) That no player chosen for a City Tea in a trophy tie shall take part in any school game on the day of the City match.
(b) City Trophy Football – a school may postpone a match if any player be called upon for such a game.
18. Cups and Shields shall be held for one season and can never be won outright.
19. In accordance with ESFA Regulations, all school teams must be in the charge of a teacher during any match. The referee (other than the teacher-trainer), unless appointed by the LSFA must be approved by both teachers – trainers.
20. (a) In the event of a tie in any league, goal average shall not count.
(b) FIXTURES – as per rules governing particular age groups.
21. Pupils playing for a first team in any age group shall not be eligible to play for an 'A' team in that age group. If, however a player is dropped from a first team he/she may then play in the 'A' team.
22. When ANY knock out competition has reached the last eight teams, referees may be appointed by the executive who shall also appoint the referee and select the ground for ALL semi-finals and finals.
23. (a) That in the event of a drawn game in a cup-tie, extra time may be played by mutual consent. In the event of a replay the match shall take place on the visitors' ground within eight days and, if again a draw, extra time must be played. Should further replays be necessary, the Secretary must be consulted. Extra time for U19 be 12 minutes each way; U16 & U15 be 10 minutes each way; U14, U13 & U12 be 7 minutes each way; U11 & U10 be 5 minutes each way.

(b) In all trophy semi-finals and finals extra time must be played on the first occasion if the result at full time is a draw, unless the Emergency Committee decide otherwise. In a final after extra time, the Emergency Committee shall decide whether there shall be a replay or trophy shared.
24. That in case of a team withdrawing from the league its record shall be expunged.
25. Pupils attending schools affiliated to Airedale and Wharfedale Schools' Sports Association must represent Airedale in the West Yorkshire U11 Competitions.
26. That the General Secretary shall have executive power to arrange any match when necessary.
27. A team be not eligible for membership, if, in the previous Season, it did not fulfil at least half of its official fixtures, and, if in the opinion of the Committee, there were not extenuating circumstances to account for this.
28. Objections shall be considered by the executive as appointed under Rule7(a), or by the committee as appointed under Rule 10.
29. In any game, the teacher/referee must not allow any player to take part who is not wearing shin protection.
30. Any player sent off in a school game will be automatically suspended from playing under the auspices of the LSFA for a period of four League or Cup games. Subject to any appeal, in writing being lodged with the Hon Secretary within three days. The Hon Secretary must be notified of all sending's off by the referee and / or teacher in charge of the player's team.
31. Any matter not provided for in the foregoing Rules shall be dealt with as the executive thinks fit, and its decision shall be final. In the event of an expulsion, an appeal may be lodged within three days of notification.
