The early exchanges were dominated by the York midfield who passed the ball fluently, carving out an early opportunity which was well saved by the Leeds keeper [Chris Littlewood](#).

A free kick on the right hand edge of the penalty area drifted narrowly over the bar as York continued to pressure the Leeds goal.

12 minutes before half time, York got their just desserts when a free kick from 25 yards was smashed home by the York defender Zak. The Leeds team could count themselves lucky only to be one down at the break when the management opted for a 4 3 3 formation to provide a more attacking threat in the second half. Excellent approach play from [Rhys Walker](#) was headed goal-ward by [Joel Haley](#) and a fine move led to the equalizer with [Clifford Kondadu](#) putting a through ball to [Danny Edwards](#), who drifted a ball over the keeper from the edge of the penalty area to put Leeds back on terms.

Leeds continued to press with further chances for [Cameron O'Connor](#) who came close on the hour following a cross from [Jonathan Kayij](#). The final 15 minutes were dominated by York, with only the exploits of the Leeds 2<sup>nd</sup> half keeper, [Fletcher Paley](#), denying a certain York goal and last ditch defending from [Cameron Dyas](#) who cleared off the line in the closing stages. With time fast running out, [Joshua Bell](#) threaded the ball through to [Devon Ward](#) who found Danny Edwards in space, and with virtually the last kick of the game, a sweetly struck shot from fully 20 yards beat the keeper to his right hand post to earn Leeds all 3 points.

A thoroughly entertaining game, played on an excellent surface, with York enjoying the lion's share of possession with Leeds returning back with the spoils.
