

## Hull SFA U13 v Leeds SFA U13

Leeds created further chances to score but were unable to find the net for a third time. A free kick from just inside the Hull half evaded everyone to find the Hull striker in front of goal who finished well to set up a nervy finish to the match. The Leeds defence stood strong and the team were good value for their 2-1 win rising them to second in the table with a game in hand on the teams around them.
